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Attempted ATM Theft

(WICHITA, Kan.) – Crime Stoppers of Wichita-Sedgwick County is seeking information regarding a suspect attempting to access multiple ATM's in East Wichita.

On June 16th, at approximately 4:00 a.m., surveillance video from an ATM in the 4100 block of E. Harry shows a suspect approaching and using a prybar to attempt to gain access to the ATM. The suspect failed to get any money, but caused significant damage to the machine.

The same suspect is involved in at least three other cases – one the previous morning, June 15th, at approximately 1:30 a.m. in the 2000 block of N Webb, one on the 16th around 2:00 a.m. in the 11000 block of E. Harry and another on the 16th around 3:00 a.m. in the 4800 block of E. Douglas.

The suspect has a similar means of accessing machines in each case. He has been seen wearing a black Nike hoodie with matching Nike sweats, black shoes, and a black mask. He uses a long blue prybar to gain access to machines. He also wears a red drawstring backpack and has a tattoo on his left forearm. He has been spotted driving a newer model Silver Toyota Tacoma quad-cab pickup truck.
